PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED HOSPITAL CONVEYANCE TRANSACTION

May 26, 2026

Saint Thomas Stones River Hospital, LLC d/b/a Ascension Saint Thomas Stones River hereby gives notice of a proposed public benefit hospital conveyance transaction involving Saint Thomas Rutherford Hospital d/b/a Ascension Saint Thomas Rutherford.

The text of the written notice provided to the Tennessee Attorney General and Reporter under Tenn. Code Ann. § 48-68-203 is as follows:

I write on behalf of Saint Thomas Health d/b/a Ascension Saint Thomas ("AST"), regarding an anticipated internal restructuring involving Saint Thomas Stones River Hospital, LLC, a Tennessee non-profit public benefit limited liability company, which owns and operates an acute care hospital located at 324 Doolittle Road, Woodbury, Tennessee 37190 ("Stones") and Saint Thomas Rutherford Hospital, a Tennessee non-profit public benefit corporation which owns and operates an acute care hospital located at 1700 Medical Center Parkway, Murfreesboro, Tennessee 37129 ("Rutherford"), both subsidiaries of AST.

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice to your office of an anticipated merger of Stones into Rutherford, whereas Rutherford is the surviving legal entity (the "Merger"). There are no anticipated changes to the operations of Stones or Rutherford as a result of the Merger. The parties anticipate the Transaction will occur on or after July 1, 2026 (the "Effective Date"). Please find a diagram of the transaction is enclosed.

Attached you will also find the Public Benefit Hospital Request for Information Packet, which has been completed by Stones and Rutherford.

If you require any additional information regarding the Transaction, please let me know at your earliest convenience.

This notice is provided pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 48, Chapter 68, Part 2.
