Six locations: three (3) Elementary schools (Cannon North, Cannon South, Eastside), one (1) Middle/Elementary School, one (1) High school, and one (1) Central office, including some portables. The bid will be to spray once per month, beginning January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027. You must be certified and licensed by the State of Tennessee for your bid to be considered.
