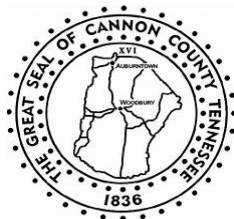

Contractors applying to bid for the prime contract and requesting Contract Documents & Specifications and Construction Plans in electronic PDF must provide the following information: Name of Company, License Number, Expiration Date of the License, License Classification, Company Address, Phone Number, and email address. The Official list of bidders will be maintained by, and available through, HAZEL ENGINEERING, LLC ONLY to ensure eligibility requirements of the bidders are met prior to the bid opening date and time. Any Bid Proposal submitted from an interested party that has not met the bidder requirements, followed the instructions to bidders, and/or has not obtained the free Electronic PDF format Contract Documents & Specifications and Construction Plans from HAZEL ENGINEERING, LLC prior to the bid opening date and time shall NOT be opened.

The Owner & CANNON COUNTY FINANCE DEPARTMENT, has absolute discretion and may for any reason, waive informalities or defects found in bids and has absolute discretion to reject any and all bids. Failure of any bidder to comply shall void the bid and the envelope containing the bid shall not be opened or considered. Contractors applying to bid for the prime contract shall also include the following additional information to appear on the outside of the envelope containing the bid:

6. OWNER & PROJECT NAME
